4-601.11(A)	Observed excessive dust accumulation on the shelves of the True three door reach in. 4-601.1(A) Equipment, food-contact surfaces and utensils shall be kept clean and free of accumulated grease deposits, dust, dirt, food residue, and other debris.	05/24/2017



