2-401.11	<i>Employee personal drink in unapproved container stored on a shelf above food items in the walk in cooler.</i> 2-401.11 Employees shall eat, drink, or use tobacco only in designated areas where the contamination of exposed food; clean equipment, utensils, and linens; unwrapped single-service items can not occur. Drinking from a closed beverage container is permitted if the container is handled to prevent contamination.	08/31/2017
4-903.11	<i>Observed wet dishes being stacked before they had air-dried.</i> 4-903.11 Cleaned equipment, utensils, laundered linens, and single-service items shall be stored in a clean, dry location where they are not exposed to contamination and shall be at least 6 inches above the floor. Clean equipment and utensils shall be stored in a self-draining position that allows air drying and shall be covered or inverted. Single-service items shall be kept in the original protective package or other means that afford protection until used.	08/31/2017



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
